Last week's program – Oklahoma Blood Institute Crystal Farrimond

Everyone needs blood at one time or another for various reasons. 10% of Oklahomans donate blood. This does not seem like much but it is twice the national average.

Once donated the blood is stored and has a shelf life of approximately 42 days. Every time a donation is made the blood can be made into platelets, red blood cells, and other blood products.

The Oklahoma Blood institute collects revenues from blood processing fees that are charged to the hospitals it serves. The organization also collects money for special projects from locals businesses, schools, foundations and individuals. OBI was established in 1977 and has for major functions in the Oklahoma community.

1. Maintain a sufficient community blood supply.
2. Provide specialized medical services.
3. Educate the community and medical leaders.
4. Blood related research.
